Initial Planning

Define the event purpose (e.g. fundraising, awareness, networking)

Set clear, measurable objectives

Identify your target audience

Decide on the event format (virtual, hybrid, or in-person)

Choose a suitable date and time

Create a detailed, realistic budget

Delegate tasks and define responsibilities

Venue & Logistics

Book a suitable venue (ensure accessibility and facilities)

Consider weather and backup plans (e.g. marquees or indoor options)

Arrange necessary equipment (AV, lighting, staging)

Ensure protection is in place (public liability, cancellation cover - speak to WRS for tailored advice)

Conduct risk assessments and health & safety checks

Confirm arrangements for security, first aid, and safeguarding

Organise food and drink (consider dietary requirements)

Marketing & Promotion

Create a marketing plan with key dates (consider a hashtag or branded campaign name)

Design promotional materials (flyers, social posts, banners)

Promote via website, social media, email newsletters, and local press

Send out invites and RSVPs

Engage local businesses or influencers to boost reach

Fundraising & Finance

Set clear fundraising targets

Secure sponsorships or partnerships

Organise raffles, auctions, or competitions

Track income and expenditure accurately

Apply for grants if applicable

Choose donation/payment methods (online platforms, contactless, cash) and plan safe cash handling procedures:

- Limit the amount of cash on-site where possible
- Use secure cash boxes and restrict access to authorised staff
- Arrange regular collection or secure storage during the event
- · Avoid counting cash in public areas
- Have two people present when handling or transporting money



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Legal & Compliance

Obtain relevant licenses (music, alcohol, lottery etc.)

Check insurance cover is adequate (contact WRS for advice)

Confirm all GDPR requirements are met for data collection

Ensure safeguarding procedures are in place for children/vulnerable adults

Register with local authorities if needed

Volunteers & Staffing

Recruit and brief volunteers and staff

Provide training where necessary

Allocate roles (e.g. welcome desk, raffle coordinator, tech support)

Create an event-day contact list for coordination

Event Day

Arrive early and do final checks

Set up signage, registration, and donation stations

Welcome guests and make announcements

Take photos and gather content for use in postevent updates and future promotions

Monitor timings and manage crowd flow

After the Event

Thank attendees, donors, and volunteers

Share outcomes and success stories (funds raised, feedback)

Post photos and updates on social media

Evaluate what went well and what can be improved

Report back to trustees and funders

Finalise paperwork, close the budget, and archive event materials
